You may nominate yourself, a member of our school family, or a member of St. Joseph parish to serve on the School Board (must have children enrolled in SJS). Persons whose names have been submitted will be informed of their nomination. Names will be randomly drawn from the pool of nominees by the School Board Chairperson.

School Board Roles and Responsibilities

- The Board serves in an advisory capacity to the School Administration and Pastor in approving and implementing policies, establishing communications and evaluating program effectiveness.
- School Board Membership is for a three-year term, with an option for one additional three-year term.
- New members are encouraged to attend an orientation session in August, sponsored by the Archdiocese of Louisville to become familiar with the functions of the School Board.
- School Board Meetings are conducted monthly on the third Wednesday of the month (occasional exceptions are made because of schedule conflicts).
