The Athletic Board believes that all players, coaches and parents will do their best to promote Christian values. That they will play and coach at levels of competitiveness that place learning and developing sport skills first and foremost above winning. Sportsmanship and respect for our competitors must NEVER be compromised. The Athletic Board strives to maintain a cooperative spirit among parents, coaches teachers and student athletes that will make it possible for out student athletes to develop into Catholic leaders in the parish and community.

### CONDITIONS FOR BEING SELECTED TO COACH ATHLETICS AT SAINT JOSEPH SCHOOL

- Each coach of Grades 4 thru 8 will be required to complete the National Youth Sports Certification Training (NYSCA) provided by the Bardstown Recreation Department. The Saint Joseph Athletic Department will pay the cost of the course. The NYSCA Certification is not required if you are certified through the KHSAA or other acceptable Public or Private School Board certification. Certified teachers are exempt from the NYSCA Certification requirement.
- Each coach is required to have a criminal records check and a signed Sexual Abuse Policy Statement on file.
- Each coach is required to have a scheduled Parent Meeting prior to the first scheduled practice at which time all business relating to and established by the Athletic Board will be presented.
- Each coach must promote good sportsmanship and coach in a manner whereas each athlete can have fun and view their success in terms of meeting their own goals rather than feeling their success is based on the success of the team.
- Each coach must be prompt with the start and finish of practice as scheduled while devoting enough time to each student athlete so as they may progress in the skills of the game in which they are participating.
- Every practice must be open to parent observation.
- Each coach must be willing to collect the Permission Form, Authorization for Treatment Form, Medical Waiver Release Form, Sports Evaluation Form, The Athletes' Pledge, and Parents' Pledge Form. You are responsible to collect this information and the pre-determined participation fee by the third practice and return it to the Athletic Director.
- Each coach must be willing to allow each player a fair amount of playing time. Be willing to fill out game reports, team rosters, etc. and turn them in promptly to the designated personnel.

At the conclusion of the school year, each coach will be evaluated using the guidelines and plicies listed in the Athletic Handbook and rules for the league in which they were chosen to coach.

By signing below you confirm that you are willing and able to comply with all the statements and requirements listed. I understand that after being interviewed, whether by telephone or in person by the Athletic Board's appointees, the Athletic Board will approve one head coach and one assistant coach for each team.
