

St. Joseph Athletic Board Minutes  
February, 9 2022

Mr. Haun gave an update on the Intermediate Boys' Basketball league. The season is nearly half way through. Some games that were snowed out on 2/5/22 have been rescheduled. Changes have been made to the schedule the past two weekends in an attempt to make up missed games.

Gina Hoskins gave a report on volleyball. The season has just begun. Gina asked if a group had a fundraising event could the money earned be used for that group. The board all agreed that would be fine. The difficulty would be in bookkeeping as "Athletics" is just one account. All money that comes into athletics through fees, gate admissions and concessions go into that account. All expenses (uniforms, game officials, concession items, equipment) comes out of that account. Mr. Haun will check with Marda to see if there is a way to earmark particular income within that account.

Sean Anderson gave a report on archery. The last state qualifying tournament is Saturday, Feb 12th. If the team or individuals qualify for the state tournament, parents will be responsible for the tournament fees. Sean is looking into having an early season tournament next year and moving archery to the parish hall.

The finance report was given.

There was a discussion about putting banners in the gym for teams that win their conference and conference tournament. Members of the board are going to attempt to find the years that St. Joe teams have won one or the other or both. The board also wanted to include the Academic Team for their championships.

Intramural volleyball was discussed. The season will begin after Spring Break. It was approved to charge \$1 at the gate for games. Mr. Haun will be in charge of sign ups. Nick Thurmond and Michelle Fabek will help determine teams and set a schedule.

Mr. Haun received an email from Conrad floors that it was time to re-do the gym floor. This includes sanding the floor down, repainting all the lines and logos and finishing with coats of polyurethane. The cost before logos is \$15,000. Mr. Haun was asked to check with the school/parish about helping with or paying the cost.

In a previous meeting, new scoreboards had been discussed. Mr. Haun presented two quotes for two new scoreboards with installation and removal and disposal of the old boards.
